

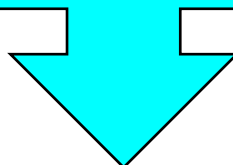
How home learning looks if an individual has to self-isolate



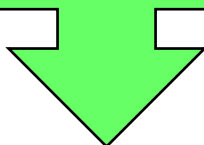
*If a child is too unwell to complete the work; there is no expectation that the work is to be completed.



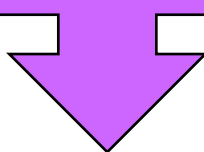
When a child goes home they will be sent with a physical pack of work, if this is not possible it will be delivered by staff to the child. During the absence the school office will contact each day to check in on the child.



On day 3 of the child's absence the class teacher will call them to see how they are and how they are getting on with their work.



Parents can deliver work to school (if safe to do so) and teachers will email feedback to the child.



This process is then repeated for the second week or when the child returns. Teachers and SLT will regularly catch up about how any children who are isolating are getting on with their home learning.
